Below is a recent practical example of another Public Sector organisations benefitting from our bespoke and highly competitive managed service offering:

Example:

THE CHALLENGE:

A hospital was facing delays with phase 1 of their Electronic Patient Record (EPR) implementation due to interfacing problems with the supplier. In order to avoid significant delays with subsequent phases of the programme the hospital opted for an ongoing managed service flexible solution to enable completion of phase 2 of the implementation. This would enable the programme to roll out both phase 1 and 2 across the hospital by March 2021.

OUR APPROACH:

We ultimately work as an extension to the client project team, evidenced by our commitments to knowledge transfer and flexibility in our approach to delivering programme requirements.

Our service focuses on creating clarity in the work schedule that our team is expected to deliver. Clarity is evidenced in the form of a SOW created between the client project team, our project leads and our in-house project support team.

With clarity around the work schedule we are able to deliver high calibre project resources to meet the specific requirements of the agreed work schedule, that complement other permanent members of the Trust's team. Throughout the lifecycle of the programme we were able to provide project office support to ensure that the services provided by our team remain on track.

We also continue to work with the client project team to review the programme delivery and associated resource plan. This enables us to plan for the provision of additional project resources or to scale down. One of the key outcomes of this approach is the consistent provision of high-calibre project resources who are effectively on-boarded, ready to be productive from day one on-site.

THE RESULT:

Our project delivery team worked closely with the hospital Programme Director to ensure all the required resources for the project are of consistently of a high calibre, ready to be productive from day one and on-boarded to the agreed resource schedule.

We also provided project fact finding and scoping workshops, resource scheduling and provisioning, PMO Services, on and off-Boarding as well as service governance.

Other PMO services include:

- Bi-weekly / monthly project board – resource planning and progress report updates
- Quarterly full-service review
- Collaboration with the hospital to maintain a live operational resource scheduling plan
- Provide services to help create a work schedule for each SOW requirement including any specifically agreed deliverables and any other success criteria
- Collate Real Staffing consultants and project team based SOW progress reports
- Report to the Trust on progress of each live assignment
- Report on risks and issues
- Support with IR35 queries.
